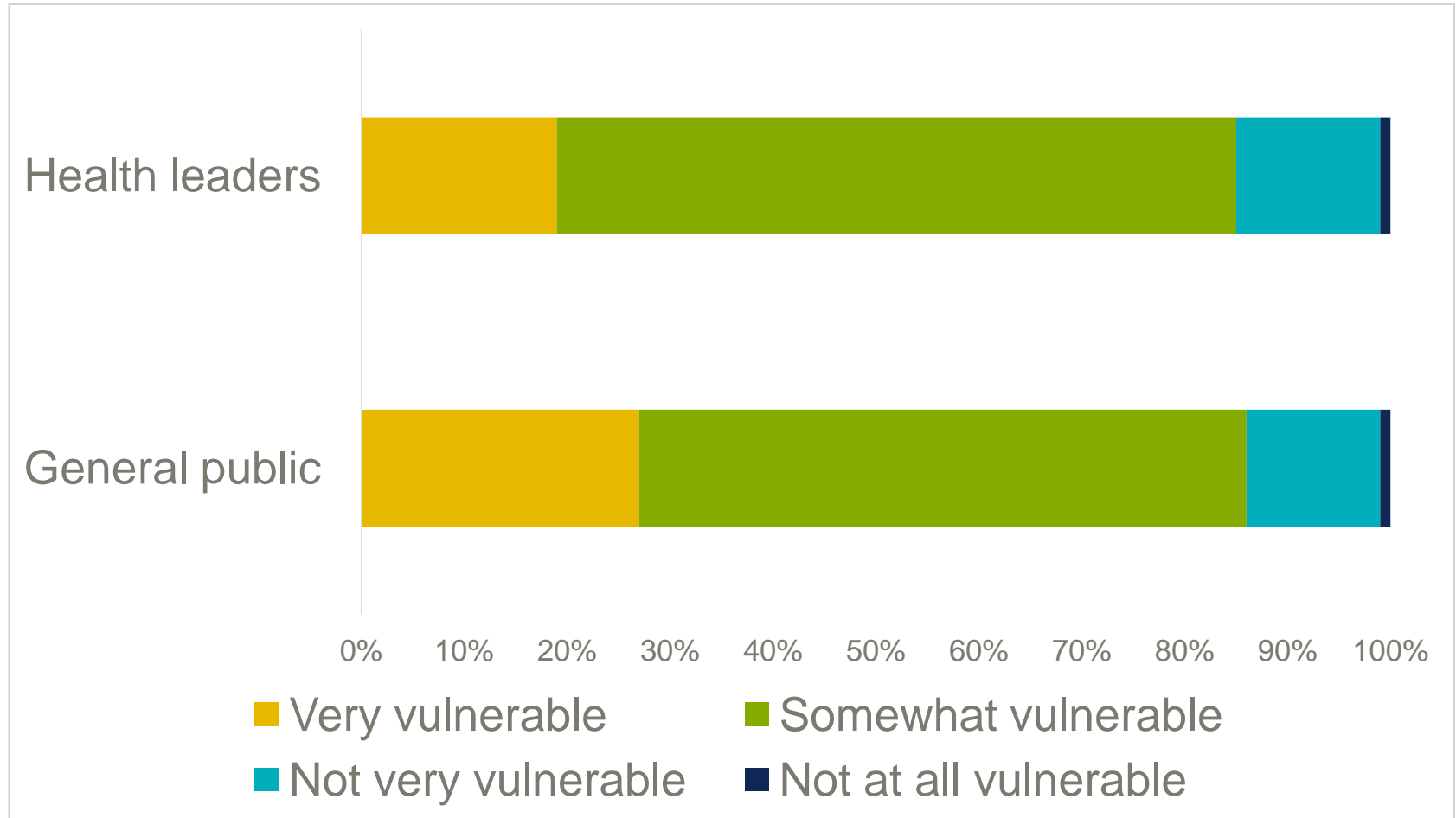

EXAMPLES OF CYBER RISKS IN CANADIAN HEALTH SECTOR

Hackers using a phishing attack accessed hospital payroll files and made 'significant' transactions

Automated e-booking of false appointments led to a temporary reduction in blood collections

Malware led to temporary loss of hospital systems - some servers and systems had to be replaced

Hackers redirected job applicants to a site where they were asked to pay to process applications

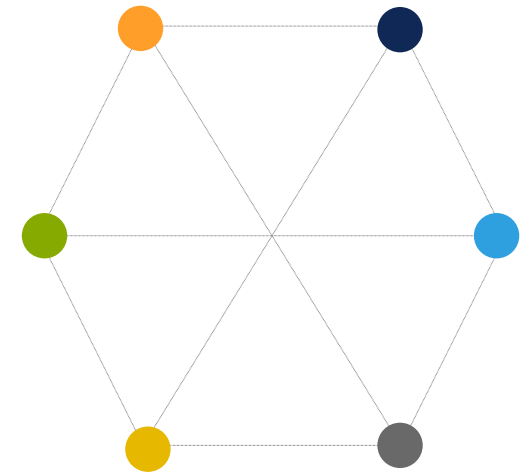
