DATA SOURCE

- NATIONAL ONLINE SURVEY OF 1,988 CANADIAN ADULTS
- CONDUCTED FROM DECEMBER 3 TO 7, 2020
- COMPARABLE MARGIN OF ERROR IS + 2.2%, 19 TIMES OUT 20.
- DATA WEIGHTED TO MATCH THE CANADIAN POPULATION BY GENDER, AGE, EDUCATION, REGION, AND OFFICIAL LANGUAGE.






WHAT'S THE ABACUS DATA

% MORE WORRIED ABOUT COVID-19 IN PAST WEEK









PERFORMANCE OF HEALTHCARE SYSTEM IN YOUR PROVINCE








